Job Role and Summary

A QA Automation Tester is responsible for evaluating the quality of the software by automated testing. He/She develops and conducts different automated tests to check the products, applications, and systems of the company. A QA Automation Tester looks for bugs and glitches of the software or product and reports it to the developer.

A. Duties and Responsibilities

1. Creates test automation networks.

3. Collaborates with the developer department and engineers to come up with a stable software product.
4. Creates and performs test automation by using hardware and software test tools.
5. Improves test automation.
6. Guarantees the consistency of the automated tests.
7. Estimates the accurateness of the test.
8. Implements and creates an automated testing plan.
9. Evaluates and checks the accuracy of the automated test approaches.
10. Performs a verification, evaluation, and installation of the system testing.
11. Assists in product designing to easily come up with automated test strategies.
12. Documents the results of the test.
13. Reports and verifies the bugs and glitches of the software.
14. Creates a criterion of the automated tests.
15. Works with the program and development team in meeting the quality needs and preferences of the customers.

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16. Creates test plans to comprehend objective requirements.
